Lacey returned to the top of South Jersey, Group 3 in dominating fashion yesterday.

Lacey, No. 5 in The Star-Ledger Top 20, received three touchdowns from Jake Dabal and two TDs apiece from Jarrod Molzon and Craig Cicardo en route to a 56-7 victory over Delsea in the South Jersey, Group 3 playoff final in Lanoka Harbor.

The title was the fourth for Lacey, which last won a playoff championship in 2006 when it captured South Jersey, Group 3. Delsea, which had won the South Jersey, Group 2 title a year ago, was bidding for its 10 playoff championship.

Dabal, who broke free for an 84-yard TD run in the first period, ran 11 yards to ta touchdown in the second period when Lacey scored three TDs to break away to a 28-7 lead at the half. Molzon had a 14-yard scoring bolt and Cicardo ran into the end zone from a yard in the second quarter.

Dabal ran 10 yards for his 11th TD of the season and Molzon scored on an 8-yard burst in the third period when Lacey built a 42-7 lead. Molzon ended with 14 TDs this season.

Cicardo scored his 18th touchdown of the year when he dashed 13 yards to a TD and Zach Torrell returned a fumble eight yards to the end zone to complete the scoring in the final period.

Tyler Coulbourn ripped off a 45-yard touchdown run in the first period when Delsea had evened the game at 7-7. Coulbourn ended the season with 14 TDs.
